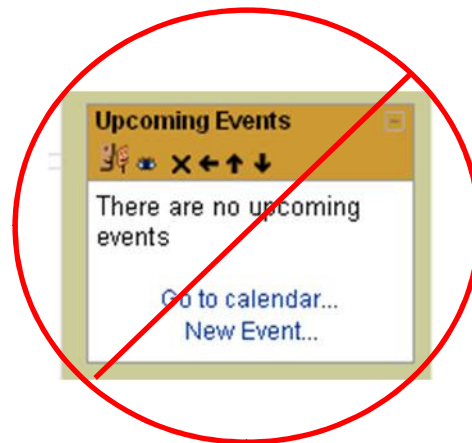



New Version of Moodle Allows for Drag and Drop

No more Arrows

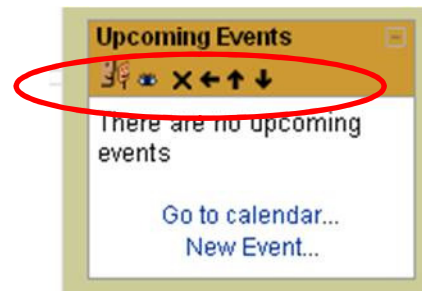


Older Version of Moodle

- To move blocks within the older version of Moodle you had to....
 - Turn Editing On 



- Then you would move the block using the Arrows



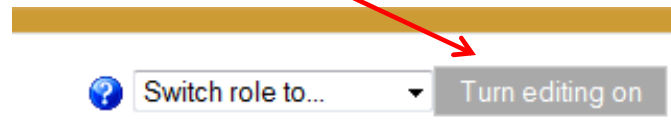
- The block would move one space at a time. You would continue to click on the arrow until it arrived in the desired position.



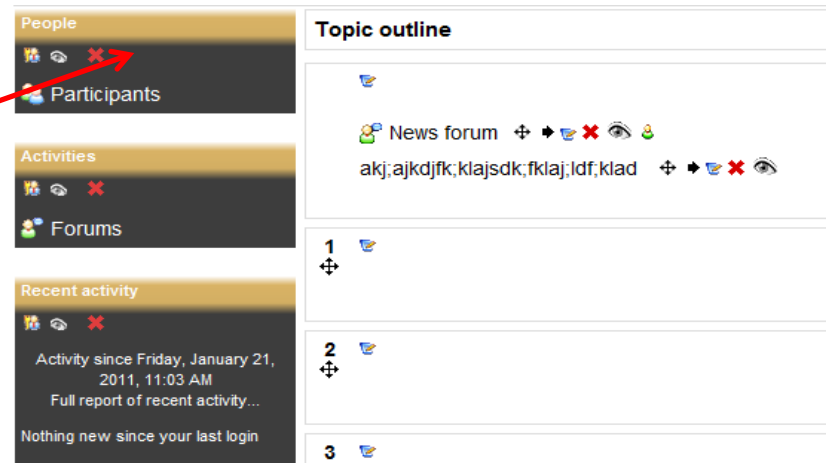
Moodle Now has Drag and Drop


To Move a Block

Move your mouse over the block you wish to move

Left click your mouse and hold down

Hold your mouse down while dragging to the desired location

Release the mouse when in position

Sticky Blocks

- Sticky Blocks are blocks that cannot be moved or deleted
- The Bracket Library block is an example of a Sticky Block
- Sticky Blocks do not contain edit icons
- Sticky Blocks remain full color when in Edit mode
