Item 1 Change Order of Two Pharmacy Courses
PHA 502 Christian Bioethics is currently offered in the P1 year. PHA Spiritual and Professional Values is currently offered in the P3 year. Dr. Forrest Smith made a motion to drop these two courses and replace them with two new courses PHA 506 Spiritual and Professional Values in the P1 year and PHA 709 Christian Bioethics in the P3 year. The information for these changes has been in TRAC for review (Appendix 1). This motion was seconded by Dr. Dan Tullos and approved by committee vote.

Change order of two Pharmacy courses

Faculty in the College of Pharmacy propose that two courses exchange place that are currently taught in the program. PHA 502 Christian Bioethics taught in spring of the first professional year will be exchanged with PHA 708 Spiritual and Professional Values taught in the spring of the third professional year. Both courses are two hours credit. Course descriptions, curricular content, and educational outcomes of both courses will not be affected by the exchange. If the exchange is approved, course numbers will be changed to reflect the year the course is taught. New course numbers: PHA 506 Spiritual and Professional Values; PHA 709 Christian Bioethics.

Rationale: First professional year students have not been taught clinical skills or been exposed to clinical settings in which ethical dilemmas arise. Instructor Evaluation comments note repeatedly student lack of understanding of the purpose for bioethics training. In addition, scores on the Defining Issues Test (DIT) do not change after the course. Bioethics training is more relevant to third professional year students who have several years of clinical training and pharmacy and healthcare settings that require resolution of ethical dilemmas.
