Four payments must be paid to Harding University before you can participate. The payments and due dates are listed below. Explanation of fee and payments follow.

- **APPLICATION FEE (\$400)** - paid at the time of application. **This fee is non-refundable** if you drop out of the program.
- **TRAVEL PAYMENTS (\$1,200 & \$1,200)** - include round-trip airfare from Little Rock, day tours and International Student ID. **PLEASE NOTE: No frequent flyer tickets may be used for the flight. All arrangements are made by the International Programs office.** Frequent flyer miles may be accumulated.
- **FINAL PAYMENT (\$5,846)** - includes entrance fees, tour guides, room and board, tech fee and credit for eight hours tuition. See course menu below.
- **DON'T FORGET SPENDING MONEY!** You will need to provide your own spending money and we recommend that you allow up to \$80-\$85 per day for all independent travel (optional). (You may return to the USA with the group upon conclusion of the program or you have the option of returning to the USA from select cities so that you can independently travel on the European continent at the end of the program at your expense.)
