BASIC APPLICATION PROCESS

1. **SUBMIT THE FAFSA** - Apply for federal financial aid by submitting the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at www.fafsa.gov. Be prepared with parent and student tax return information.
2. **COMPLETE OTHER FORMS** - For most students, only the FAFSA is needed to apply for financial aid. If your FAFSA is selected for verification (you will be notified), you may be asked to submit additional information and even tax documentation to the financial aid office. Obtain required forms at www.harding.edu/finaid.
3. **ACCEPT FINANCIAL AID OFFERS** - Accept your financial aid and complete any additional requirements in Pipeline (pipeline.harding.edu), Harding's portal
 - Login to Pipeline, click on My Info > Financial Aid > Review My Financial Aid
4. **COMPLETE ENTRANCE COUNSELING** - If student loans are desired, complete Direct Loan Entrance Counseling at www.studentloans.gov
5. **COMPLETE MASTER PROMISSORY NOTE** - If student loans are desired, complete a Direct Loan Master Promissory Note at www.studentloans.gov
