Eligibility Requirements:

- o No student is eligible to attend Harding University International Programs while on academic, chapel, or disciplinary probation. Any student who has applied and/or been accepted will automatically become ineligible if placed on any type of probation. Such individuals will be allowed to participate ONLY if there are openings after probation has been removed.
- o At the time of participation, you must have a 2.0 GPA and have at least 27 credits completed by the semester prior. Those not having a 2.0 GPA or 27 credits completed will be placed on a waiting list and moved to the main list ONLY if there are openings once the GPA and credit hours are up to the requirement. If you are an entering freshman, you will be placed on the active list but you must still maintain a 2.0 GPA to participate.
- o HIZ students are selected from a pool of applicants. For this program only, a minimum 2.5 GPA is required. Complete and return the accompanying form with this application.
- o If you are an intercollegiate athlete, seek permission from your coach before applying to any international program. If you are receiving an athletic scholarship, the athletic scholarship will not pay for any portion of an international program.

Fee Statement: The application fee is \$400.00 and must be collected before your name is put on a list.

I understand that my application fee will be forfeited if I withdraw from the program even if there is a waiting list for that semester. I understand that if I remain on the waiting list, the application fee will be refunded at the start of the subsequent semester, unless I choose to relocate to another semester. I also understand that I will be charged a fee of \$50.00 to change to a semester other than the one I have marked on this application.

No student is eligible to attend HIZ who is currently on academic, chapel, disciplinary, or excessive class absence probation on the Searcy campus. Any student who has applied and/or been accepted will automatically become ineligible if placed on any type of probation up until time to depart. Such individuals will be placed on a waiting list and may go only if there are openings after probation has been removed. At the time of participation, HIZ students must have an overall GPA of 2.5 and have at least 27 credits completed by the semester prior.
