

English Proficiency Exam Policy

In order to graduate students must satisfy the English Proficiency requirement in one of the following ways:

- a. Pass Eng 249
- b. Earn a grade of “B” or higher in HNRS 201 or in both Eng 111 (or 113) and 211 (or earn CLEP credit in Eng 111 (or 113) and a grade of “B” or higher in 211)
- c. Earn a grade of “C” or higher in 281 at Harding.
- d. Receive credit in Eng 111 and 211 at Harding through the Advanced Placement Program or International Baccalaureate Program.
- e. Pass the English Proficiency Examination (EPE) after reaching junior standing. You may take this test only 4 times, and you may not take it after you earn 105 hours (unless they you have prior approval from Dr. Long)
