

Harding University AP Exam Policy

Harding grants credit to incoming freshmen for courses completed in the Advanced Placement Program of the College Entrance Examination Board. A table of available AP exams, the minimum qualifying scores accepted by Harding, the courses for which qualifying scores students may earn credit, and the number of hours which may be earned, are printed below. No grade is assigned and no tuition is charged. A recording fee is charged for each course recorded on your transcript. (See Below) **Credit earned by AP exams MUST be recorded on the transcript in the first semester of enrollment at Harding.**

**History majors: History majors should apply the AP U.S. History credit to the specific course (either HIST 1010 or 1020) which they have the greater mastery of, while enrolling in and taking the course in which, they have lesser mastery. This decision should be made in consultation with the student's academic advisor.*

How do I get AP exam credit on my Harding transcript?

Students must send an official AP score report from College Board to the Harding Office of Testing before or during the first semester enrolled. Once the office has verified the score, a process will begin to record course credit to a student's transcript. When the process is complete, course credit will be recorded on the transcript and the students' account will be charged. Any changes to a student's transcript must go through the Registrar's Office. Harding requires a \$85 recording fee for each course recorded on the student's transcript. There is a maximum of \$340 for all exam credit. (Fees are subject to change.)
