The application cycle for OTCAS is from mid-July to March 6th annually.

- ☐ Submit official transcripts from each college or university to OTCAS.
- ☐ Submit three letters of recommendation.
- ☐ Complete the personal statement in OTCAS.
- ☐ Complete the supplemental questions in OTCAS

COMPLETE PREREQUISITE COURSEWORK

Complete the following prerequisite courses prior to start of the summer admission term with a minimum grade of a "C."

Prerequisite courses must be taken within 7 years of application.

- ☐ Sociology or Anthropology (3 hours)
- ☐ Abnormal Psychology (3 hours)
- ☐ Lifespan Development/Developmental Psychology (3 hours)
- ☐ Statistics (3 hours)
- ☐ Anatomy and Physiology (with lab) (8 hours)
- ☐ Medical Terminology (1 to 3 hours or a certificate completion)

COMPLETE YOUR DEGREE -

Complete a bachelor's degree from a regionally accredited college or university prior to the start of the summer admission term.

» A cumulative and prerequisite GPA of 3.0 is strongly recommended.

ADMISSIONS PROCESS

Applicants are reviewed through a rolling admissions process. However it is recommended that applicants submit their applications as early as possible.
