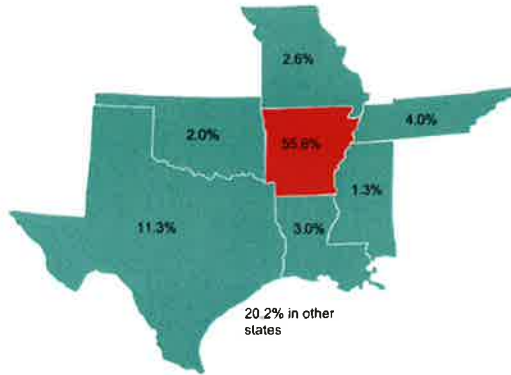


## Geographical Location of Graduates

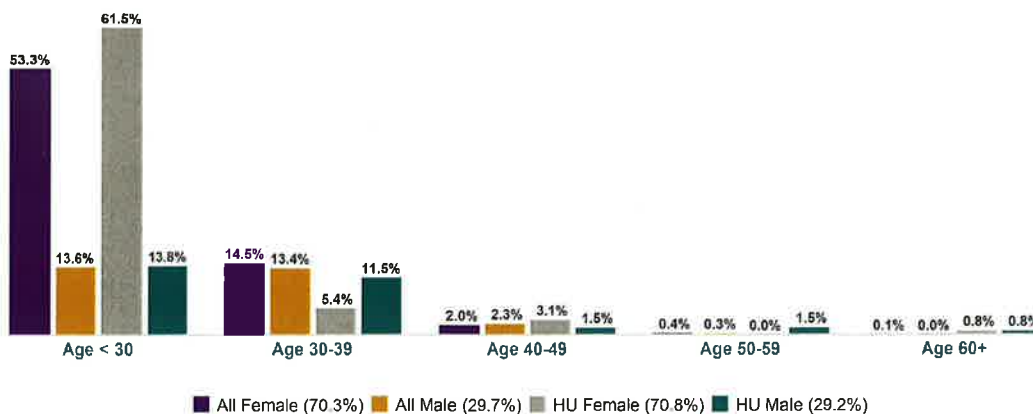

## Distribution of Recently Certified PAs by Age and Gender



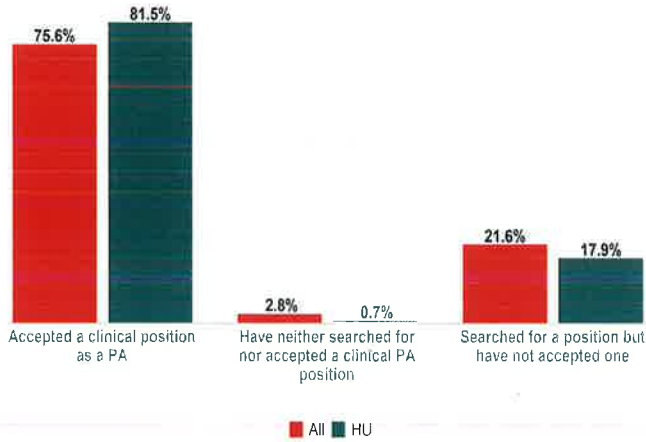

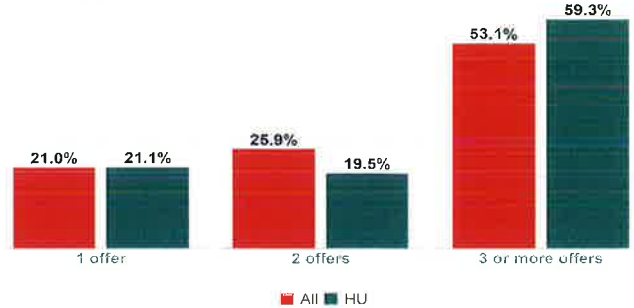

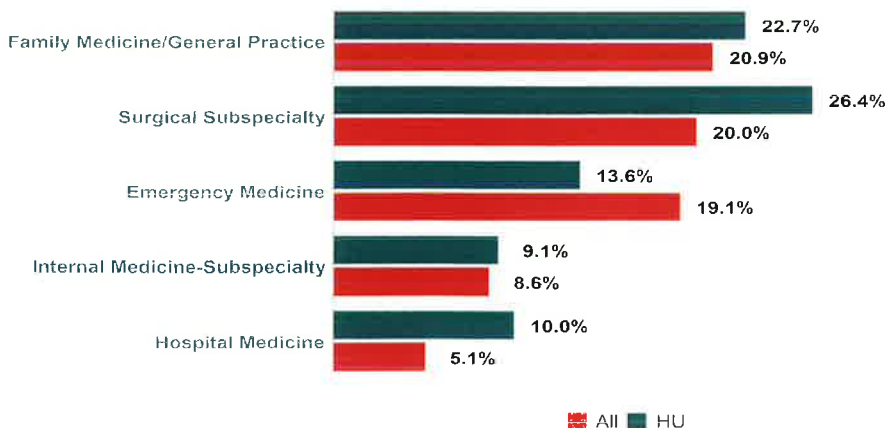
