

Applicant Harding ID# **Application** – Submit an application on our web page (apply.harding.edu/apply). 2. _____ Immunization Record – To comply with state law, Harding requires students born after 1/1/1957 to provide proof of immunity against measles, mumps, and rubella (MMR). Upload proof to the online application. 3. **Transcripts** – Except for coursework completed at Harding, have all official transcripts for graduate work sent directly from the institutions to admissions@harding.edu. _____ Cumulative GPA – Applicant must hold a bachelor's degree with a 3.0 or higher (or 3.0 on the last sixty hours) or a master's degree with a 3.0 or higher. A GPA of 2.5 to 2.99 allows for provisional acceptance and requires the student to maintain a 3.0 on the first twelve hours of coursework. _____ Educator License – Upload a copy of a current educator license. Teaching Experience – Upload documentation of at least one year of licensed teaching experience (e.g., a copy of a signed teaching contract or a letter on official letterhead with the signature of the applicant's supervisor). For Special Education Administration only: experience must be in special ed teaching, speechlanguage, or guidance counselor experience. Note: To be eligible for licensure upon completion of the program, applicants must have three years of

licensed teaching experience.
