It is very important that you check with your academic advisor as the requirements for the education major may be different for each individual.</p> <p>b) Although students may take the Praxis or ACT residual during the first semester of enrollment at Harding, it is highly recommended for students to take the Praxis or the ACT prior to enrollment.</p>
