Minimum of a total of 128 credit hours (which includes 60 hours at HU) To complete the degree program at HU

#### ADMISSION REQUIREMENT NOTE:

Students who have completed an Associate's Degree with ASU-BEEBE may enroll in the 2+2 Program at Harding without a minimum age requirement. Students who have not completed an Associate's Degree must be at least 23 years old to enroll in the Degree Completion Program at Harding and have completed a minimum of 60 hours of college credit.

- \*With an Associate's degree 3 hours of global perspective is required. Without an Associate's degree 6 hours of global perspective is required.
- \*\*Additional Bible course(s) may be required on the main campus if degree plan completion is more than four semesters.

#### PRAXIS NOTES: PRAXIS | NOTES:

- a) Be aware that the PRAXIS I is no longer accepted, but the new Praxis Core Academic Skills for Educators test or qualifying ACT scores are required and must be taken before admittance or by the end of the first semester of admittance to Harding University. It is very important that you check with your academic advisor as the requirements for the education major may be different for each individual.
- b) Although students may take the Praxis or ACT residual during the first semester of enrollment at Harding, it is highly recommended for students to take the Praxis or the ACT prior to enrollment.
