<p><b>You must see your ASU-BEEBE advisor to walk through this plan the first time!</b> Please contact your advisors with questions about this plan.</p>	<p><b>Harding Requirements to complete the degree program:</b> A minimum of 128 hours, 60 hours from a 4 year, 45 upper level hours, Minimum of 45 hours from Harding University, of those 18 hours have to be from the major and a minimum 9 hours of major must be upper level.</p>
<p><b>ADMISSION REQUIREMENT NOTES:</b> Student who have completed an Associate's Degree <i>can</i> enroll in the 2+2 program at Harding. Students who have not completed an Associate's Degree must completed all required coursework and a minimum of 60 hours of college credit to enroll. Additionally, those with an Associate's Degree must have the required coursework to enroll in DC depending on which campus they plan to attend see advisor for details.</p> <p><b>Admission to Teacher Preparation Program:</b> Transfer students with 45+ hours of required work should immediately apply for admission to the program. Must have a GPA of 2.7 or higher, with a grade of C or higher in ENG 1100, ENG 2110, COMM 1010, MATH 1200, EDFD 2020, and EDFD 2030 (or equivalent courses) at time of admission. One must submit 4 completed faculty recommendation forms (min. of 2 faculty from major) and meet acceptable standards of adjustment in the areas of personal, social, moral and ethical behavior (validation may require personal interview). <i>ACTE, CAEP and ADE may impose additional requirements for licensure and changes will be made accordingly to the program as the need arises when specified by the ADE.</i></p> <p><b>Program Retention:</b> Maintain Admission Requirements. Major, additional licensure area, and cumulative GPA must comply with a minimum of 2.7, if GPA falls below min. student will be dropped and must re-apply. Being dropped from the program will prohibit a student from completing their internship semester. <u>See the Cannon-Clary College of Education page in the Harding University catalog for more information!</u></p> <p><b>Admission to Internship II Semester:</b> See your HU advisor for applicable deadlines. <u>See the Cannon-Clary College of Education catalog page to view the current process and requirements for admittance and completion!!!</u></p> <p>Have at least a 2.7 GPA and a grade of C or higher in each professional education courses (including field experiences).
