***ALL TRAVEL PAYMENTS MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE DUE DATE**

- **TENTATIVE APPLICATION FEE (\$500)** - paid at the time of application. This fee is non-refundable if you drop out of the program. Application and fee must be received by **Friday, December 6, 2024**.
- **TENTATIVE TRAVEL PAYMENT (\$2,500)** - includes round-trip airfare from Little Rock or Memphis. PLEASE NOTE: No frequent flyer tickets may be used for the flight. All arrangements are made by the CSD Program. **(Due by January 24, 2025)**
- **TENTATIVE TRAVEL PAYMENT (\$2,500)** - includes room and board, local travel, linen/laundry, as well as admissions, accommodations, transportation and food for the end of the trip tours. Most financial aid packages should apply to your term in Zambia. Be sure and check with the Financial Aid Administrator. **(Due by February 21, 2025)**
- **DON'T FORGET SPENDING MONEY!** - you will need your own spending money.

Students must have a current passport that is valid until at least January 2026 with at least three blank pages. Students must also arrange to receive appropriate vaccinations for travel to Africa.

Limited spaces are available! We will fill available spaces in the order applications are received. Those who cancel after airline tickets have been purchased and land travel arrangements have been paid will be liable for any penalties assessed by the airline and land travel companies. Funds that can be recovered will be returned to the student's account as soon as possible. **PRICES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE.**
