The Arkansas Department of Education requires successful completion of 12 hours (these 4 courses) from an approved program of study, and the ESOL Praxis test #5361 with a passing score of 142. If you are not teaching in Arkansas, check with your state Department of Education for specific requirements for licensure in Teaching English as a Second Language and ETS for PRAXIS test requirements in each state.

An average scholarship level of 3.00 is required in all course work. No grade below “C” is acceptable for graduate credit (but will be used to calculate GPA), and only six (6) semester hours of “C” credit may be counted. These must be balanced by six (6) semester hours of “A” credit. Courses in which a grade of “C” or lower has been received may be repeated. No course may be repeated more than once.
