General Description

Leadership and responsibilities

- Recruit and direct upperclass students for the Stampede executive committee
- Serve as master of ceremonies at general assemblies of Stampede
- Plan Stampede schedule with assistance from executive committee
- Communicate with the Stampede executive committee throughout the summer
- Troubleshoot and problem solve various aspects of the programs
- Work closely with the Dean and staff of the University College

Requirements

- Must live in Searcy for the entirety of the summer
- Must be a junior by hours
- May not be enrolled in any summer courses (other than intersession)
- Excellent leadership skills
- Excellent communication skills
- Able to spend 35 hours, Monday through Friday for 10 weeks during the summer
- May not serve in any other internship or job during the 10 weeks
- Must be connected to a local congregation of the church of Christ
